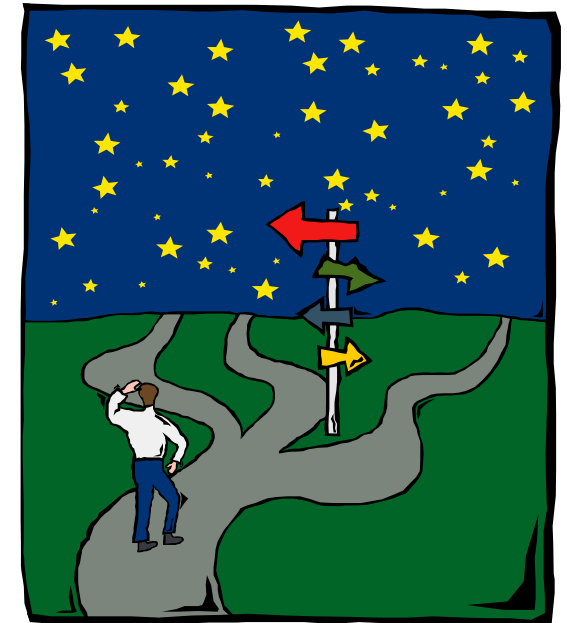

Autism does not make any separation between economic situations or level of education. We do not know why you but you now know you are not alone and there is help and support available.

WHAT HAPPENS NOW?

Depending from whom you have received your diagnosis from – Pediatrician, Family Physician – it's time to get started. Get a referral to the Kinsmen Center or the Wascana Rehab Center for a formal evaluation and diagnosis. With your diagnosis get a complete outline of what your child needs – speech & language, occupational therapy, if your child has sensory issues and what are they. Get information from SASKFEAT members, ARC, ATSS, school units, health district, and ECIP 's to find out what services are available where you live. **ACCESS SERVICES NOW – DO NOT WAIT.** There is a lot to do but remember you are not alone.
